How to Register:

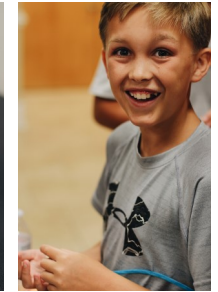
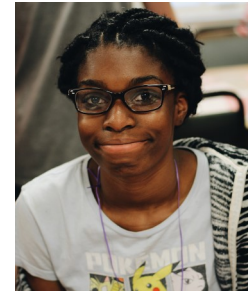
1. **Early Bird Registrations must be postmarked no later than May 11th.** Add \$35 to all registrations after that date. (Please note that T-shirts may be unavailable to campers registering after May 11th.)
2. Registration Forms are available from your church or online at <http://www.savannahpresbytery.org/events/youth/summer-camp/>
3. Complete the Camp Registration & Canoe Consent forms. Turn in the completed registration forms to your church registrar OR mail directly to the presbytery at address below.
4. Check-in is at 4 p.m. on Monday for all camps except **“Overnight at Ebenezer—A Family Experience”** which begins on Friday at 4 p.m.
5. Confirmation letters will be emailed in early June. **Please make sure your email address is legible!**
6. **Refund Policies:** We are unable to refund camp fees after June 1. We cannot make refunds for homesickness.
7. **Fees include** t-shirt, room, board, and everything else your camper needs to be safe and have fun!

Overnight at Ebenezer—A Family Experience

(Parents & Kids, NEW! No age requirement)

June 22-23 Cost: for one child & one parent \$140, additional children/parents maximum cost per family is \$210

Primary Camp (Rising 3rd and 4th Graders)

June 18-20 (2 nights/3 days) Cost: \$140/after May 12 \$175

Elementary Camp (rising 5th and 6th graders)

June 18-21 (3 nights/4 days) Cost: \$215/after May 12 \$250

Youth Camp (rising 7th graders—graduated seniors)

June 18-22 (4 nights/5 days) Cost: \$290/after May 12 \$325

Early Bird Pricing is good until May 11. Any registration postmarked after May 11 **must** include the \$35 late fee! T-shirts may not be available for late registrants.
